May I kindly draw to your attention to an issue that has arisen at the World Health Organisation concerning the ongoing discussions of the amendments of the 2005 treaty and the new International Health Regulations at the World Health Assembly.

To date, these treaties have not been completed and submitted to the member states. The deadline for this submission was last January. We can conclude that the WHO has violated Article 55 par 2 and has gone against its legal obligation.

On Tuesday 16th April 2024, the majority of the Dutch Parliament voted in favor of the attached MOTION by Mona Keijzer and others, all members of the Dutch Parliament.

These concerns are about the amendments to the International Health Regulations and the proposed new pandemic treaty. We have brought this to the attention of the Maltese Parliament on several occasions and nothing was discussed or actions taken.

These violations cannot be ignored any longer as they are now in breach of international law. We the citizens of the world are calling for action. Malta must not lag behind and be seen asleep at the wheel.

This irregularity must not happen. Due to this, we at Vuci Hielsa and its members have already made a public statement that we do not recognize these treaties anymore.

The same motion needs to be urgently tabled in the Maltese Parliament to instruct our government to request a postponement of the vote on the amendments at the World Health Organisation in conjunction with the IHR and the new pandemic treaty at the World Health Assembly. This will give all member states the stipulated four-month period to evaluate the process. The responsibility lies with you to table this motion to postpone this process. However if not obtained, one must vote against the proposed amendments to the IHR and the new pandemic treaty. If the WHO ignores this request, inevitable legal measures will be taken.
